Musings of a locked-down Cleric

There are some months to which I look forward; others never seem to be quite 'right'. January is one such month as for me it brings memories of several sad events apart from the foul weather which this year has been cold and wet and coupled with the national lockdown and rise in covid infections had been particularly bleak.



So I'm looking forward to February which has happier associations for me with family hirthdays and anniversaries to celebrate. The hours of daylight lengthen, snowdrops and

family birthdays and anniversaries to celebrate. The hours of daylight lengthen, snowdrops and other bulbs push up through the ground giving hope that Spring isn't far away.

February 2nd is as ever in the church the celebration of Candlemas or to give it its other title, the Presentation of Christ in the Temple. It tells of the time when 6 weeks after his birth Jesus was brought by his parents to the Temple in Jerusalem, as was the custom in those days, to fulfil the demands of the Law and make a sacrificial offering for the purification of Mary following childbirth. They would have had to buy the offering from the merchants in the Temple and as they had just two pigeons or doves, we know that Mary & Joseph were not rich people. Wealthy parents would have offered a lamb and a dove.

The Temple complex would always have been busy. Mary and Joseph would not have been the only couple bringing their child there that day and there would have been lots of other people going about their business. One of them was a man called Simeon, a righteous and devout man, filled with the Holy Spirit, looking forward to the time when Israel would be saved. We're told that the Holy Spirit had spoken to Simeon and promised him that he would not die until he had seen the Lord's Messiah (Saviour). He had faithfully hung on to that promise and when he saw the Baby Jesus he knew that this was the child – the one he had been waiting to see! He was overjoyed! God had kept His promise – not just to Simeon but to all peoples!

He took the baby in his arms and praised God. St. Luke in his Gospel account gives us those wonderful words he used which we know as the Nunc Dimittis – "Lord, now let your servant depart in peace, according to your word; for my eyes have seen the salvation which you have prepared for all people; a light to lighten the Gentiles and to be the glory of your people Israel."

Candlemas marks the end of our Christmas festivities for the year and we then turn towards Lent which this year begins on Ash Wednesday17th February.



But before that of course is Shrove Tuesday – Pancake Day! Circumstances mean we may not be able to share them with our friends or wider family this year but I hope we can enjoy a good 'pancake fest' in our homes.

And let's not forget 14th February – St Valentine's Day! - a day for all lovers and an opportunity to make a special effort to contact those whom we love and who love us throughout the year. I guess FaceTime, Zoom and WhatsApp will be busy!

We don't have to spend lots of money to do that – a kind word or action is just as important –

We all need to feel loved and perhaps in these sad days with so much sickness and dying across the world not being with those we love can make us feel cut off and adrift in the world but we are all loved – each and every one of us – by God our heavenly Father. He loves us so much that he sent his only Son, Jesus, into this world to live alongside us – that is what we celebrate at Christmas. During his life here on Earth Jesus experienced all the joy and sorrows that we have to go through. People turned against him and he was cruelly killed but death was not the end, he is with us still. And he understands us and goes on loving us even when we turn away from him or do unlovely things to each other.

'How can this be?' you may say. Well our world is in a mess at the moment – wars, a pandemic, economic disaster – but our God is with us, loving us and leading us if we will but follow him.

WALKING THE BRECKLAND WAYS FOR NHS CHARITIES TOGETHER 2021 By SANDRA JARVIS AND DOROTHY SCOTT

22nd January 2021

Both Dorothy and I had intended to start this journey on January 1st. However I have been recovering from a lower leg (calf) DVT and Dorothy has recently had a bout of high blood pressure. But we both had GP appointments Wednesday 20th January and both given the all clear to proceed.

We intend walking 500 miles this year which we both feel is doable and achievable. Our intention is to do two 5 mile walks per week plus a shorter 3 mile walk. We may do more each week or sometimes less depending on gardening/allotment needs and, of course, the inevitable grandparent duties.

Marzipan loaf cake



Ingredients

150g/5½oz marzipan (white or yellow) or almond paste, at room temperature, torn into lumps

125g/41/2oz soft unsalted butter

1 tsp vanilla paste (or extract)

50g/1¾oz caster sugar

75g/2½oz plain flour (or gluten-free plain flour)

1/4 tsp fine sea salt

1 tsp <u>baking powder</u> (gluten-free if necessary), alternatively use ¾ tsp if you are not using a food processor

1½ tsp ground cardamom

3 large free-range eggs, at room temperature

Preheat the oven to 170C/150C Fan/Gas 3 and place a loaftin liner into a 10x20cm/4x8in and 5cm/2in deep 450g/1lb loaf tin, or line the bottom with parchment and butter the sides.

The easiest way to make this is to put all the loaf cake ingredients into a food processor and blend until smooth, stopping to scrape down the sides a couple of times. If you don't have a processor, then I advise you to use almond paste rather than marzipan and beat it together with the butter and vanilla until thoroughly combined, then beat in the sugar. Stir the flour, salt, baking powder (though if you're not making this in a processor, use just ¾ teaspoon) and cardamom together. Beat the eggs into the butter mixture, one at a time, adding a third of the dried ingredients after each egg. Carry on beating when everything's in, to make sure you have a coherent batter with no lumps of almond paste visible.

Pour and scrape into the prepared tin and bake for 40 minutes (adding a loose covering of foil after 30 minutes to stop it browning any further), or until the cake is beginning to come away from the sides and a cake tester comes out clean. It wrinkles a little on top as it cools. Slice, and enjoy with a cup of tea.

THE GARDEN IN FEBRUARY

February can be another interesting month for weather – we normally get the coldest, wettest and warmest days of the winter. The days are stretching out – it should be light until after 6 by the end of the month giving promise of spring to come.

Jobs for this month:

Lawns If worm casts are a problem brush them with a broom to scatter on a dry day.

Shrubs Some shrubs such as cornus, philadelphus and bay will have rooted suckers coming from the base. These can be cut away from the parent plant and transplanted or potted up to give new plants. Don't use suckers from grafted plants (you will get copies of the stock not your prized top plant)

Hedges can be hard pruned to encourage new bushy growth

Roses Now is the time for the annual prune. Use sharp, clean secateurs and loppers. Climbers – cut out dead and overlapping branches, then tidy up. Floribundas and Hybrid Teas – prune as hard as you dare – my father used to prune established plants to the second outward facing bud from the base of the stems. You only need one bud, but you might damage it. He grew show quality roses.

Annuals Sow half hardy annuals (eg marigolds, tomatoes, dahlias) in a cold frame or cold greenhouse towards the end of the month. Sweet peas can still be sown – soak the seed overnight in cold water in the kitchen (that way you will see them in the morning and remember to plant them). Artichokes, cardoons and aubergines need a long growing season, so start off in pots on a windowsill

Perennials Finish cleaning up dead stems (the birds will have had all the seed by now). Fork over the soil lightly. New plants can still be planted, and old ones split

Fruit Finish routine pruning of fruit trees. Cut autumn fruiting raspberries down to the ground, summer fruiting cut just above the top training wire.

Vegetables If the ground is workable sow parsnips. Towards the end of the month sow early Brussels sprouts, summer cabbage, lettuces in trays. Remember a packet may contain hundreds of seeds, most of which will grow. Sow a few of each every couple of weeks. Also remember that compost is often as expensive as the seed – you can use both ends of a tray for plants which germinate at the same rate. Label well.

Relaxation There should be a few mornings when you can sit in the garden and drink your morning coffee and remember why gardens are so precious.

Horticultural produce show You never know the horticultural society may manage to hold its annual show his year (Boris permitting!!!). They have a category of the best display of tubs and/or baskets which is open to non – members, why not think about planting your containers – some suggestions next month.

FAIRTRADE FORTNIGHT: 22ND FEBRUARY 7TH MARCH

For two weeks each year at the end of February and start of March, thousands of individuals, companies and groups across the UK come together to share the stories of the people who grow our food and drinks, mine our gold and who grow the cotton in our clothes, people who are often exploited and underpaid.

In 2021, Fairtrade Fortnight will feel very different. The COVID-19 pandemic has shown us more than ever how interconnected we are globally. This interconnection is at the very heart of the Fairtrade message and is where your role begins. You are part of the Fairtrade movement and you have the power to drive long-term change, not only with your shopping choices but with your support in spreading the message. We just have to do this a little differently in 2021!

CHOOSE THE WORLD YOU WANT

In Fairtrade Fortnight 2021, we will highlight the growing challenges that climate change brings to farmers and workers in the communities Fairtrade works with. The facts are straightforward. Farmers and workers in countries such as Kenya, Ethiopia and Honduras, who have done the least to contribute to climate change, are disproportionately affected by it. They have told us that: Climate change is one of their biggest challenges right now. Low prices for their crops mean that they are struggling to fight back. With the emergence of the global COVID pandemic, the challenges that farmers face now are bigger than ever before with falling commodity prices and widespread shocks reverberating along our global supply chains. Ongoing poverty in farming communities makes it increasingly hard to cope with the effects of climate change.

CLIMATE, FAIRTRADE AND YOU

We need your help to put farmers' voices at the heart of tackling the climate crisis and share the reality of their struggles. Fairtrade works to raise the voices of farmers and workers and prioritise what they need to respond to the environmental crises unfolding in already vulnerable communities. This Fortnight, we are asking you to 'Choose the World You Want' and use your voice to tell others about the challenges that farmers face from climate change.

<u>HOW DOES FAIRTRADE SUPPORT FARMERS IN</u> THE CLIMATE CRISIS?

WHAT HAPPENED LAST YEAR?

In 2019 and 2020 we asked our government and the chocolate industry to lead the way to achieving living incomes for cocoa farmers. After two years of our campaign with broad and vibrant action from Fairtrade supporters, and new commitments from businesses, we have seen an invaluable contribution to Fairtrade's journey.

Here are some of the highlights:

Fairtrade supporters and staff handed in a 51,851 signature strong petition to 10 Downing Street and Secretary of State for International Development, Alok Sharma replied, praising the campaign and pledging to champion the Fairtrade movement.

Inspiring stories of Fairtrade cocoa farmers were seen and shared by millions online, in communities and at events across the UK.

Waitrose & John Lewis converted their confectionery range to contain 100 percent Fairtrade cocoa, and Lidl have launched their first own brand Fairtrade chocolate bar.

We are also excited to be working with our friends at Ben & Jerry's who have committed to paying a higher price, an additional \$600,000 over the next year to their 5,000 cocoa farmers. This amount is on top of both the annual Fairtrade Premium of around \$970,000 and the Ivorian government's minimum price for cocoa that all companies are required to pay.

The extra money that farmers will now receive is an important part of Ben & Jerry's wider efforts to support farmers towards closing the living income gap.

Ramblings from Brettenham

January has started very much like December ended, a lot of water on the land and there seems to be even more up in the clouds which is destined to fall here in the Brecks or close to us. The fields are very wet which has meant that the usual arable cultivations and farm activities have either been delayed or plans have had to change on a day-to-day basis.

Having regard to this and the fact that the days have been very much the same as we have not been able to get about due to the Covid restrictions which we are all under, I had informed Sue our Editor that the news from Brettenham this month would be very mundane and might not even be worth printing, but what a difference a few hours can make......



As you can see from the picture above, a considerable sized bomb had been unearthed, this being found in the middle of a rather large field of approximately 22 ha, as the arable cultivations in preparation for the next season were being carried out. After further investigations it was decided to contact the Police, who duly arrived on site, the bomb squad were then informed of the find, they set off from Colchester and all the necessary wheels were set in motion to make sure that nobody was injured or anything untoward happen to the bomb before the necessary explosion could be arranged.

As the day drew to the end, the police were on site and would be for the remained of the night, the army vehicles would be arriving, and the necessary lifting gear would be accompanying them.

Sand would have to be ordered and delivered to the field so that the bomb, could be very cautiously lifted from the original area it was found prior to being placed in a sand lined hole. All was presumably going to plan until Peter received a call at 10.00pm to inform him that they were stuck, and please could a tractor go up to the field and pull them out!! - Job done, it was going to be an incident to be completed the following day.

The morning duly came, and the sand was expected but where was the field...., phone calls back and forth and eventually by lunchtime the delivery was made, the deep hole dug, and the area all lined ready for the explosion. A few of us had thought it would be something which might be of interest so had permission to stand a long way back from the explosion eagerly awaiting the Bang!!

After a countdown, with cameras poised, the button was duly pressed, and breaths were held. We were ready to feel the ground move, to witness a large upsurge of soil and to cover our ears to protect them from the noise, but *No Nothing like that happened at all*, there was a puff of soil and a bang, which was nothing much more than the fireworks which are usually displayed at New Year. and turned out in fact to be the ammunition the army had used to pack the area ready for the destruction of the bomb!!

We later learned that the bomb had probably been a practice one, as no ammunition seemed to be present when exploded, but of course you can never be too sure, and it is always better to be safe than sorry.

On a high note, we did have the enjoyment of an army helicopter flying over the field, this makes a change from the Ospreys which we often have over the village and which seem to use Brettenham as a marker point. Several other aircraft and schnooks tend to turn and head off across to the 'battle area', sometimes flying so low they seem to skim the typical Breckland trees – known to many as the Douglas Firs and making us think 'they may be visiting us for tea!!

All in all it does make you realise that we are very fortunate that we have people who are able to risk their lives and use their skills to keep us safe in so many ways. Bomb disposal, the Army, the Police as well as the NHS and all front line workers who protect us all in our day to day activities. We must all take heed wearing a mask, keeping our distance and importantly respecting others in order that we can keep well and hopefully in the future be together for fellowship and friendship.


